1. Financial Statements - Kirsten Hunter

- Uncommitted \$29,000 currently

2. Funding Requests

- Chromebooks \$8,000 was approved originally for 32 Chromebook, however SCHS is not allowed to purchase from just anyone, to purchase the 32 computers from and RVS approved vendor, an additional \$4600 is required. We have a contract in place and that must be followed. With the purchase of the new Chromebooks, we will be prepared for Diploma and PATs in the spring.

- Leadership looking for casino funds for the purchase of 35 Basketball style jerseys to be used when there are events. Front of the jersey will have the phoenix logo. Back says Leadership. Quote for jerseys = \$2,170.75 plus tax. = \$2,279.29

- Leadership \$400 request for candy to get them through this year would need to come out of school council money.

- Funding discussion Currently have \$29,248 uncommitted. There are more requests Gym, Convection oven in foods room is broken to repair will cost \$3,270, New approx. \$5200, there will be an ask in the future. Other items - Money needed to rebind textbooks so they can last a few more years, tables in the learning commons. The Society has not done any fundraising over and above the casino. May need to start looking for other ways to fundraise in the future.

What are we raising the money for and how. There will be no more money coming in the foreseeable future. We need to start thinking outside the box. Things that will enrich the program. Do we turn out a wish list to the community and see what appetite there is.

3. Gym – Tyler McRae

- Thank FOSCHSS for supporting the weight room, this will be a huge upgrade to what is currently in the gym.
- 4 squat racks with storage in between each rack for dumbbells, kettle bells. They all have the Springbank logo on them.
- Power lifting platform sports specific training.
- An Airdyne bike power hands and legs.
- 2 x elliptical trainers
- Rubber plates are also all purchased.
- The money has been put to good use and the school is behind the new equipment.
- Equipment will be at the school by the end of the month.
- Parent volunteers to flip the weight room call out will be required. Need 5 to 10 parents Tyler will confirm what is required and what equipment is required.
- To complete the Phase 1 goal with the full accessory package they are short \$7,000. Accessory package includes – kettle bells, dumb bells, slam balls.
- Long Term Vision is to get 15 new spin bikes. Each bike is about \$3000 but could get good, refurbished bikes for under \$1600.
- Next goal couple of cable machines, couple of bars.
- There is a Sports performance training program that is J block before school.
- Some staff classes are being held.
