

ALBERTA HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

You must earn a **minimum** of 100 credits from the required courses below:

REQUIRED COURSES

- ➤ English 30-1 or 30-2
- > Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
- Mathematics 20-1 or 20-2 or 20-3
- Science 20 or 24 or Biology 20 or Chemistry 20 or Physics 20
- > Physical Education 10 and Career and Life Management (CALM)



AND EARN 10 CREDITS, IN ANY COMBINATION, FROM: (almost anything EXCEPT Social Sciences, Work Experience, and Green Certificate)

- Career and Technology Studies (CTS)
- Fine Arts (Drama, Music, etc)
- Second Languages
- Physical Education 20 and/or 30

AND EARN 10 CREDITS IN ANY 30-LEVEL COURSE(S) (in addition to English and Social Studies), IN ANY COMBINATION, FROM:

- > 30-level math, science, fine arts, second languages, CTS, social sciences, or physical education
- > 30-level Work Experience; Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP); and/or Green Certificate



How and When YOU Monitor Graduation...

- Check credit criteria checklist on MyPass throughout school year
- ► January final and diploma marks for semester 1
- ► June and July final and diploma marks for semester 2

*Note: MyBlueprint and Power School <u>do</u> <u>not</u> accurately represent credits.

How and When <u>WE</u> Monitor Graduation...

- October/November initial grad credit checks
- November Semester 1 midterm check (are you passing all your courses?)
- January exams and final marks for semester 1
- April Semester 2 midterm check (create final graduation list in May)



Graduation List

Process:

- The graduation list will be drafted in **April**.
- If students are not in a position to graduate, they will not be on the list.
- Students and parents/guardians will be contacted with a <u>letter in April</u> if they are not on track to graduate.
- Students who are not on the grad list, might not be able to participate in the commencement ceremony.






At Risk?

- Monitoring throughout the year




Why is MyPass Essential?

- ► To access student's Detailed Academic Report (unofficial transcript)
- ► To order official transcript for postsecondary applications (\$10)
- To find Diploma Exam marks, final grades and awarded credits
- ► To register for Diploma Exams (if you want to rewrite)




Transcripts


- Students order transcripts from MyPass accounts (\$10)
- If institutions require a transcript to be sent directly from the school, please contact Ms. Chen
 - Students must provide a properly addressed envelope and postage
 - Requests must be made a minimum of two days in advance

Diploma Exams

- Mandatory
 - SCHS will register students automatically for classes taken at SCHS
 - Students taking courses from outside providers including We Connect will self-register for diploma exams via MyPass (see Ms. Chen for help)
 - Extra time is a universal accommodation for diploma exams (up to 3 hours)
 - Diploma exams are worth 30% of students' final grade
