#### **Summer School**

- Abbreviated semester: July 2 29
  - You will only have under 4 weeks to complete a course that usually takes 4 months
- Online learning: you are not required to work on campus but are strongly encouraged to (30% increase in success rate)
  - Core courses
    - Some in-person assessment
    - In-person final exam

#### Summer School

- Only RVS grade 10-12 students are permitted to register; current grade 9's not permitted
- Can register in a maximum of one 5 credit and one 3 credit course in addition to RAP
- Can only take a total of 10 credits including Work Experience
- No placeholder registration should not register if currently working on desired course
- Registration is not guaranteed; first come, first serve.

## Should I take summer school?

- You are a fit for summer school if:
  - Can be physically present to take assessments and in person writing assignments on campus
  - Can put in 4-5 hours a day, 5 days a week in July (each core course takes about 80-100 hours to complete)
  - Can complete first module by July 7

- You should not take summer school if:
  - Working in July (unless taking Work Experience)
  - Out of province in July
  - Do not have access to a computer or the internet

- Must register yourself to write the diploma exam (August 2025) through MyPass
  - Writing centre: Rocky View Schools Education Centre (0404 Airdrie Learning Connection)
  - Permission from Bob Rodgers
  - Deadline to register is July 3
