SPRINGBANK COMMUNITY HIGH SCHOOL VALEDICTORIAN SELECTION & APPLICATION GUIDELINES Graduating Class of 2025

Below are the guidelines used to select the valedictorian at Springbank Community High School. We ask that all applications are submitted by **Friday**, **April 4th**, **2025**, *digitally* to the selection committee at <u>jwilhelm@rockyview.ab.ca</u>. The successful candidate will be notified by Thursday, April 17, 2025, and a copy of their Valedictorian Address (speech) will be due **May 7, 2025**.

The Valedictorian must have demonstrated academic achievement (90% + average), have received at least two years of their schooling at Springbank Community High School, have participated in school activities, shown good character/citizenship throughout their high school years, and embodied RISE characteristics across a variety of domains (Responsibility, Integrity, Strength, Excellence).

The Valedictorian Selection Committee, made up of the Scholarship Committee members, will choose the Springbank Community High School Valedictorian each year. The Valedictorian will be the student with the most points out of 100 points, awarded using the following criteria and process. Ties will be broken by the students' academic score or possible interview.

CRITERIA:

Academic achievement (70 points maximum)

Scholastic averages for Valedictorian nominees will be determined by using Canadian University General Admission Requirements (English 30-1, 3 Approved Academic Courses, and 1 Approved Academic Course or Approved Option).

Please note that students who took English outside of the province (MEI/Blythe) do not qualify. The levels achieved in Semester I and at the mid-term of the second semester (**April 11, 2025**) will be the benchmarks used for this calculation. The top student will be awarded 70 points. Other students will receive a score based on how far apart their average is from the top student's average.

I. Involvement/Character/Video/Short Essay (30 points maximum)

A. CLASSMATE (4 points maximum)

Each student will be scored out of 4 on the number of years they attended Springbank Community High School.

B. PARTICIPATION (10 points maximum)

Each student will be scored on the number of **school** activities in which they participated. The criteria will be set i.e. adequate participation vs. simple attendance and would be verified by the respective Staff Advisor. The student would be responsible for reporting, on a form, the activities in which they are involved and the time commitment.

C. CHARACTER (10 points maximum)

Each candidate will be required to submit, on the proper form, examples of helping others and contributions to the betterment of the **school** community. This will include three references from staff and/or peers attesting to the student's caring, ethics, and integrity. At least two of the references must be from staff members and sent directly by the staff member to the committee at <u>jwilhelm@rockyview.ab.ca</u>. Students must give staff members at least 2 weeks advance notice.

D. VIDEO (3 points maximum)

Each candidate will be required to submit a video of around 1 minute (MAX 2 minutes) on the topic of their Valedictorian Address and the focus of what they'll speak ato in their speech.

E. PARAGRAPH / ESSAY (3 points maximum)

Each student must provide a brief paragraph, 250 words or less, answering the question: Why do you think you should be selected as the valedictorian of Springbank High School's 2025 Graduating Class?
