

High School 101 Summary

Graduation Requirements:

- Minimum of **100 credits**
- English 30-1 or 30-2
- Social Studies 30-1 or 30-2
- 10 additional credits at the 30-level (besides English & Social)
- A 20-level Math course (20-1, 20-2, or 20-3)
- A 20-level Science course
- Physical Education 10
- CALM (Career and Life Management)
- 10 credits in CTS, Fine Arts, Second Languages, PE, or other approved courses

Credit System:

- Semester class = 5 credits
- Quartered class = 3 credits
- By the end of Grade 10: approx. **41 credits earned**

NEW Grade 10 OPTIONS:

FAST TRACKING BIOLOGY

• The first opportunity is a Fast-Track Biology pathway for students entering Grade 10. Those accepted into this program will complete Science 10 in Semester 1 and Biology 20 in Semester 2. When students transition to Grade 11, they will be enrolled in Biology 30, providing them the advantage of completing a diploma-level course ahead of schedule. We also plan to group these students together for all three classes to create a collaborative learning environment.

ADVANCE PLACEMENT ENGLISH 10 and 20

• Our second opportunity is Advanced Placement (AP®) English for grade 10 and 11 students next year. This rigorous course allows students to earn university credit when they complete the grade 12 level. In addition to gaining valuable preparation for post-secondary academics, AP® courses stand out on university applications and provide students with a competitive edge during the admissions process.

MATH 15

- Math 15 is a support course designed for students who would benefit from additional time to strengthen foundational math skills while remaining on the academic (-1/-2) mathematics pathway.
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- By taking Math 15, students "slow down" the content of Math 10C, allowing for deeper understanding and reinforcement of core concepts. Students will complete **Math 15** alongside Math 10C to stay on track with the academic sequence.
- Students with a Grade 9 math mark between **50% and 70%**, or students who need extra time to develop strong mathematical foundations.

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


Student Schedule

• Includes eSocial (Social Studies in French) & FLA (Français Langue Première)


Student Schedule - French Immersion

Student Schedule - Global Sports Academy




Fast Track BIO:

• Students take **Biology 20** in Grade 10 along with regular courses






